Code of Conduct | Staff

Teachers, Staff & Coaches in charge of teams directly affect the behaviour of children under their supervision. They should pay due care to their conduct and be aware that their every-day decisions and actions have ethical implications.

As a teacher, member of staff or coach at a fixture / event / competition I will:

- ***Promote the emotional and physical well-being of the children ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child or team to win.***
- ***Respect the officials and their authority during fixtures / events / competitions and will never question, discuss, or confront them at the fixture / event / competition.***
- ***If I have a problem, I will speak to the event organiser.***
- ***Display good sportsmanship at all times.***
- ***Display high standards of behaviour and appearance.***
- ***Be a good role model for those in my care.***
- ***Be responsible for my actions.***
- ***Encourage children and spectators to display a sports person like attitude.***
- ***Guide and encourage children to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.***

As staff we completely acknowledge that I lead by example. Young people are extremely impressionable – we set uncompromising standards. We want staff to be passionate about students' developments & we take pride in success but we win and lose in the right way.
